

Downloading accessMobile File

Step 1:

You will need a Bluetooth enabled laptop or desktop or the phone cable to transfer this file to your phone, and your phone must be a java enabled phone.

- Download and save the file (.Jar) to your computer desktop.
- Switch on your phone's Bluetooth.
- With your Bluetooth enabled laptop; transfer the file to your phone using the Bluetooth application.
- Or with your phone cable, transfer the file to your phone.

Please note: Once you have the download file on your phone, you can also transfer to another person's phone via Bluetooth. accessMobile download file is also available on our intranet (Infopool).

Step 2:

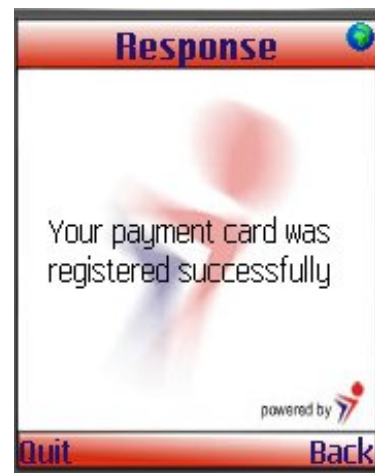
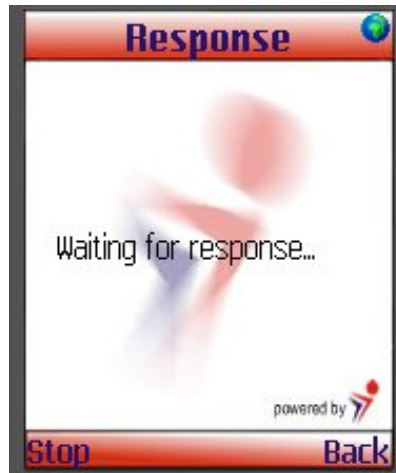
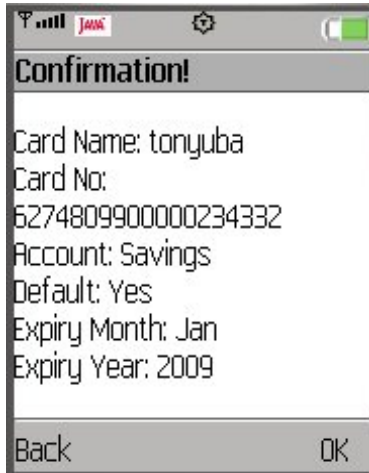
Installing accessMobile Application on your phone

- Open your message inbox or application folder to install the application.
- Click on install and follow the screen guide clicking "yes" or "continue" to finish the installation.
- Enter your G.S.M phone number, and enter it the second time for confirmation.
- Type "Access" as card name for Access Bank debit card.
- Enter the 19 digit PAN (Personal Authentication Number) on the debit card.
- Enter "Savings" or "Current" as Account default.
- Enter Default card as "Yes".
- Enter the "Expiry Month" and "Expiry Year" as indicated on the debit card.
- Click on "Register".
- Click on "Ok" to confirm your card details.
- With your GPRS enabled phone it connects via appropriate network GPRS and it displays a confirmation message on your phone. However, if GPRS fails network SMS is used and you will receive a text message for confirmation. Network charges apply accordingly for SMS.

- Check your account balance to confirm workability.

Please note: Accessmobile file works with all types of phones (Nokia, Sony-Ericcson, Samsung, Motorola etc)
